

LGCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

September 17th 2024

The meeting began at 10:00 AM. at the Clements Community Center. Officers present were Kathy Hall President, Sandy Seader Vice President, Ken Pfohl Treasurer, Bob Burroughs Public Relations Officer, Tom Robben VOTR, and Bill Hall. Jane Walker, Secretary, was absent.

Public Relations Officer: Robert Burroughs reported that he handed out and spoke to several people at the Emich Car Show about joining LGCA and at the time several seemed interested but as of this date no one has contacted him to get more information about meeting dates.

Treasurer: Ken Pfohl reported that a check for dues was sent to The Collector Car Council of Colorado, so the club is paid up to date. Ken said he was looking into the benefit of changing from QuickBooks to Quicken Checkbook for keeping track of the Club's expenditures. Right now, we are paying six hundred seventy-four dollars a year (\$674) for QuickBooks and Quicken is just over one hundred dollars a year (\$100.) It appears that using Quicken would be easier to transfer the information from one person to another when a new Treasurer takes over. Kathy Hall asked Ken to get Bob Chelle's opinion using Quicken before we made any decisions about making the change.

Vice President: Sandy Seader mentioned the process of vehicle registration for the Emich Car Show went a lot smoother this year than last year, and that could be attributed to this being the second year and that we opened a little earlier than last year. Overall, she thought the Car Show went well.

President: Kathy Hall said they attended Bob Duerr's mother's celebration of life September 15th and presented them with a wind chime the club purchased in memory of Bob's mother.

The Emich Car Show's 50-50 raffle brought in Twelve hundred sixty-six dollars (\$1266) for Dave's Locker. Kathy met Sherry from Dave's Locker and presented her with the money.

Kristelle Nielsen and Kathy Ball sold Corvette merchandise at the Emich Car Show.
