Minutes from April 5, 2023

Meeting was held at the Colorado Springs Falcon Police Station starting at 7:35 allow for any late arrivals due to the snowy weather.

Leo Boyle did not attend so we did not get a legislative report.

Minutes were accepted for the March meeting.

Treasurer Budget report was accepted. Which included Federal taxes paid in the amount of \$1,388 and Colo State taxes paid in the amount of \$274.00

Dick Thompson spoke at length about the CCCC Car Show and swap meet at Rocky Mtn Metro Airport on August 5th:

Viet Nam Helicopters will be showing their copter; there will be a large tent (20x20) that will have tables and chairs for attendees to use for eating food and to get out of the sun; the car show will have advertising on two radio stations and Advertising in the 'SCOOP'; The Colorado State patrol will have four vintage cars attending; there will be a display of vintage motorcycles; Also a display of vintage campers.

The next discussion had to do with the Concours d' Elegance on June 4th. Dick stated that he will not be contacting clubs to encourage participation in the "Evolution of the Automobile" portion of the show. Instead, Tom Scott of Concours d' Elegance will be contacting the CCCC

representative for each club to ask for people to bring their cars to the "Evolution of the Automobile". The First Vice President, 2nd Vice President and a couple of club representatives brought up that most likely they would not have club members participating due to the high cost of admission, \$50 per car, and that there would be no judging or awards for the participating cars. The consensus was that the club cars would gain nothing for their time and appearance and it would cost them \$50 to bring a car.

Next on the list was the CCCC being the featured club for April at Gateway Classic Cars, 14150 Grasslands Dr, unit A, Englewood, CO. The show date is April 29th at 8:00 am. Coffee and donuts will be served to the drivers of the cars. CCCC receives \$10 for each car that attends, up to 20 cars maximum for the pay out. There is no limit on how many cars can represent the CCCC. So, this is a good donation to the club coffers.

Gary Canady who has been organizing the Dust and Shine events at the Forney Museum, is no longer doing this due to health issues. Forney is looking for a new person to take over for Gary. This is a volunteer position. Also, for Forney, they will be featuring vintage firetrucks with the help of the Hook & Ladder Club.
